RETAIL FOOD ENVIRONMENT INDEX

There is growing evidence that what people eat- and their likelihood of being overweight and unhealthy – is affected by the food environment in which they live.

The RFEI is a measure that divides the total number of fast food restaurants and convenience stores by the total number of supermarkets and produce vendors. The result is a ratio of healthy food choices (represented by supermarkets, produce vendors and farmers markets) versus unhealthy food choices (fast food restaurants and convenience stores). A score of less than 1 is ideal.
