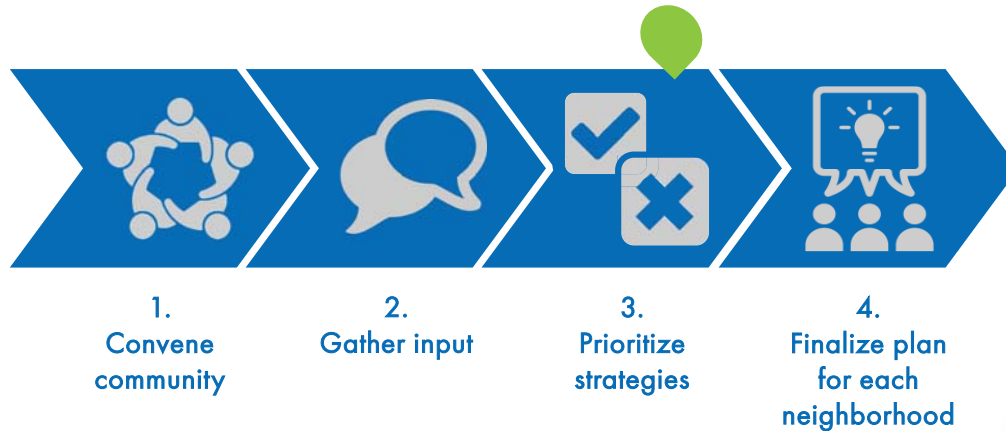

4. All SMC **systems** are **accessible, coordinated and** eliminate racial disparities.



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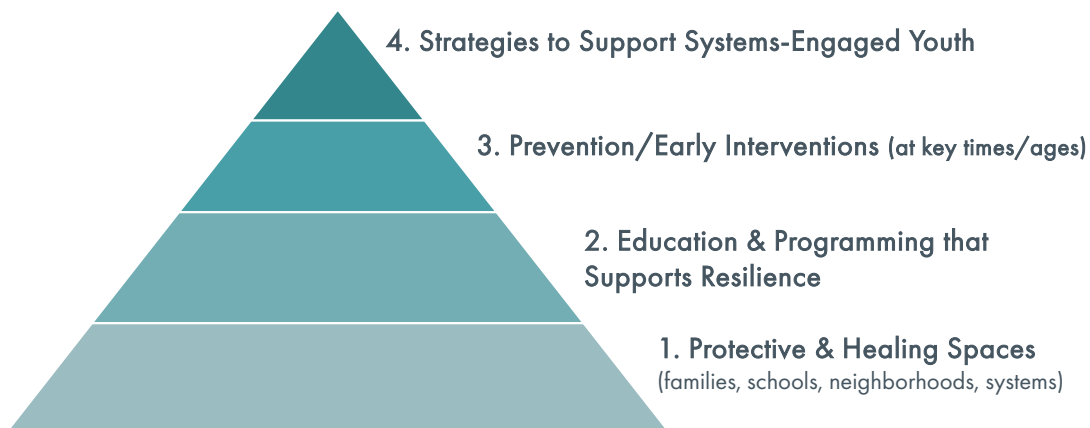

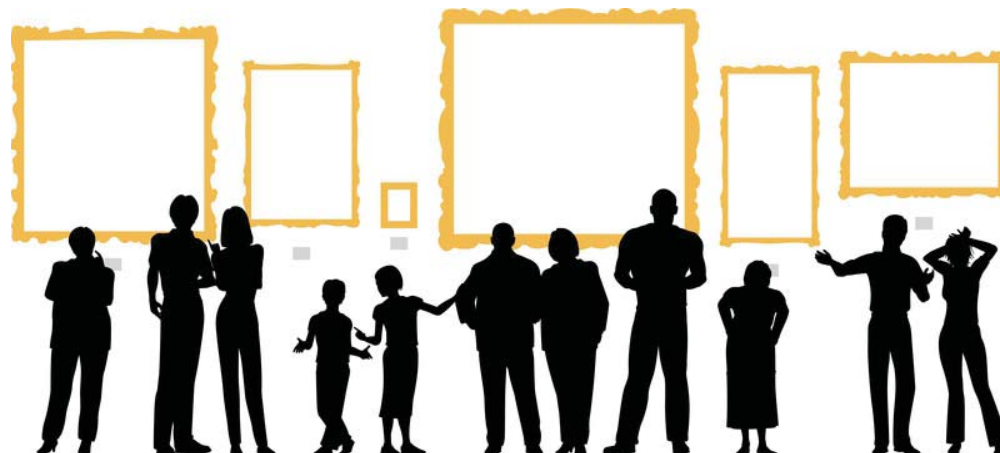


HIGHLIGHTED FINDINGS

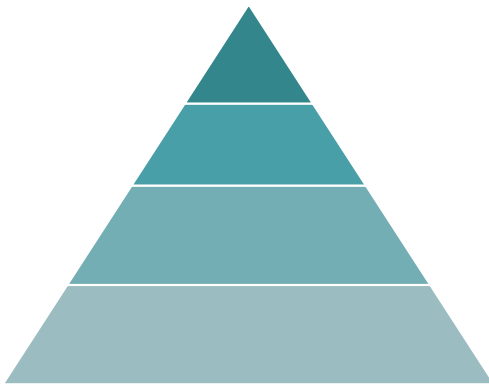

CCCS FRAMEWORK TIERS RELATIVE COST



\$ = lowest cost

(use one \$ 100 dollar bill)



\$\$ = moderate cost

(use two \$ 100 dollar bills)



\$\$\$ = highest cost

(use three \$ 100 dollar bills)
