




What is the highest level of education your parents completed?




How strongly do you agree or disagree with the statement, "I am happy to be at this school."?




How strongly do you agree or disagree with the statement, "I feel safe in my school."?




During your life, how many times have you been "high" from using drugs?




Examining Data through Equity Lens

- Look at relationship between 2 or more variables (cross tabulation)
- Cross tabulate by equity-related variables
 - Race/ethnicity
 - Living situation
 - Parents' educational attainment
 - Free or reduced price meals eligibility


- Language spoken at home/English proficiency
- Sexual orientation
- Gender identity

What is the highest level of education your parents completed?




What is the highest level of education your parents completed? (Disaggregated by race/ethnicity)




How strongly do you agree or disagree with the statement, "I am happy to be at this school."?




How strongly do you agree or disagree with the statement, "I am happy to be at this school."? (Disagree disaggregated by living situation)




How strongly do you agree or disagree with the statement, "I feel safe in my school."?




How strongly do you agree or disagree with the statement, "I feel safe in my school."? (Disagree disaggregated by gender identity)
